### What Projects are Eligible?

A partial list of eligible projects includes:

- Lighting systems and controls
- Motors or variable frequency drives and pumps
- Building insulation
- Heating and air conditioning modifications
- Automated energy management systems/ controls
- Cogeneration
- Solar or photovoltaic (PV) systems
- LED traffic signal retrofit
- Streetlight conversions
- Water/wastewater treatment plant process improvements

### What Facilities are Eligible?

- Existing buildings
- New construction
- Other energy using facilities

### How Much Money is Available?

The California Energy Commission has up to \$30 million available for loans that can finance up to 100 percent of the cost of your energy projects. The maximum loan amount is **\$3 million per application**. There is no minimum loan amount.

### How Low is the Interest Rate?

Now you can receive a reduced interest rate as low as 4.1 percent by completing your projects and invoicing us by the following dates:

Required Project Completion & Invoicing Date	Interest Rate
By December 1, 2007	4.1%
By April 1, 2008	4.2%
After April 1, 2008	4.5%
