A Review of Transmission Losses in Planning Studies

As part of estimating the amount of electricity needed to serve load in California, a reasonable assumption must be made about how much energy is lost due to electrical resistance in the transmission and distribution system. Staff has reviewed multiple sources of assumptions regarding the amount of energy lost between the generation source and the end user and summarized these findings in a report titled *A Review of Transmission Losses in Planning Studies*.

Because estimates of transmission losses are an important element of the demand forecast, staff is seeking input from interested stakeholders and industry experts. Comments on this topic should be directed to Docket #11-IEP-1C.
