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Joe,

When i talked to the Northern orange County water board, they opened the drill logs because I wasn't asking for a full report. I asked to see down to 200ft for drilling and five hundred feet for safety. they gave me depths of 700ft. We felt that if Geothermal caught on those tables could be handed over to the cities where they would charge a fee for a Geothermal Bore hole inspection thus distancing us from true well drilling. Along with another field inspection to view a pressure test before grouting the loops down the bore hole. Things like Cassions or field loops are already covered by inspections.

The Local DWR first asked for a environmental Impact report on grouting in a aquifer. But now they have given me a pass just to work see how things go. We did however limit the use of the type of drills we use in urban areas. The same problems with concussion drilling also came out in the Portland conference.
