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**Notice of Second Addendum to the  
LOCALIZED HEALTH IMPACTS REPORT  
for  
Selected Projects Awarded Funding Through the  
Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology  
Program Under Solicitation PON-09-006  
Publication CEC-600-2010-005-AD2**

The Energy Commission is required under California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Chapter 8.1, Section 2343(c)(6), to consider the localized health impacts and environmental justice when approving projects for funding.

*The Localized Health Impacts Report for Selected Alternative and Renewable Fuels Infrastructure Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-09-006* was posted May 28, 2010, and the 30-day public comment period ended June 28, 2010. An addendum to this report was posted on May 27, 2011, and the 30-day public comment period ended June 26, 2011.

The Energy Commission has published a second addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that analyzes new locations of a project proposed for funding under the Program. The addendum was publicly available on March 22, 2013.

The new station locations proposed, in relation to SCAQMD, "Natural Gas Infrastructure for the South Coast Air Basin" are:

- Clean Energy Fontana- 14226 Valley Blvd., Fontana
- Clean Energy Coachella- 45601 Dillon Rd., Coachella
- Waste Management Chino- 13793 Redwood Ave., Chino
- West Covina City Yard- 825 S. Sunset Ave., West Covina

For the Pearson Fuels Project the Perris location has been removed and the new location proposed is 2365 E. Sepulveda Blvd., Carson.

The addendum to the report includes a description of the project, criteria emissions data for the fuels associated with the project, demographic data for the area where the project will be located, and an analysis of the impacts of this project in communities with the most significant exposure to air contaminants or localized air contaminants.
