## **Notice of Second Addendum to the LOCALIZED HEALTH IMPACTS REPORT**

### ***Selected Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program Under Solicitation PON-11-602 Publication CEC-600-2012-004-AD2***

The *Localized Health Impacts Report for Selected Alternative Fuel Infrastructure Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-11-602* was posted on April 27, 2012, and the 30-day public comment period ended June 1, 2012.

On August 16, 2012, the California Energy Commission posted a Round 2 Notice of Proposed Awards resulting in additional projects proposed for funding under the Alternative Fuel Infrastructure grant solicitation PON-11-602 an addendum to the Localized Health Impacts Report was posted on September 21, 2012. The Energy Commission is required under California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Chapter 8.1, Section 2343(c)(6), to consider the localized health impacts and environmental justice when approving projects for funding.

The Energy Commission has published a second addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that analyzes additional projects proposed for funding under the Program. The addendum was publicly available on November 29, 2012.
