Notice of Addendum to the LOCALIZED HEALTH IMPACTS REPORT

Selected Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program Under Solicitation PON-09-608 Publication CEC-600-2011-002-AD

The *Localized Health Impacts Report for Selected Hydrogen Fuel Infrastructure Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-09-608* was posted on May 6, 2011, and the 30-day public comment period ended June 6, 2011.

The Energy Commission has published an addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that identifies address changes to the locations of two of the hydrogen stations proposed by Linde, LLC and assesses the potential localized health impacts. Specifically, Linde, LLC plans to install two hydrogen fueling stations at existing gasoline stations at the new addresses shown below. The name of this project is Linde LLC, "Linde West Sacramento and San Juan Capistrano Hydrogen Fueling Stations".
