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**Notice of Second Addendum to the  
*LOCALIZED HEALTH IMPACTS REPORT*  
for  
*Selected Projects Awarded Funding Through the  
Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology  
Program Under Solicitation PON-11-604*  
Publication CEC-600-2012-005-AD2**

The Energy Commission is required under California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Chapter 8.1, Section 2343(c)(6), to consider the localized health impacts and environmental justice when approving projects for funding.

The *Localized Health Impacts Report for Selected Advanced Vehicle Technology Manufacturing Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-11-604* was posted July 25, 2012, and the 30-day public comment period ended August 27, 2012. An addendum to this report was posted on December 4, 2012, and the 30-day public comment period ended January 4, 2013.

The Energy Commission has published a second addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that analyzes a new location of a project proposed for funding under the Program. Trexa LLC's project "*TREXA BEV M9 Pilot Production Facility and Third Party BEV Business Accelerator Facility*" has changed location of the project from 411 S. Hewitt Street, Los Angeles, CA to 2200-2322 Signal Street, San Pedro, CA. The addendum was publicly available on November 1, 2013.

The addendum to the report includes a description of the project, criteria emissions data for the fuels associated with the project, demographic data for the area where the project will be located, and an analysis of the impacts of this project in communities with the most significant exposure to air contaminants or localized air contaminants.
