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**Notice of Third Addendum to the
LOCALIZED HEALTH IMPACTS REPORT
for
*Selected Projects Awarded Funding Through the
Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology
Program under Solicitation PON-09-608*
Publication CEC-600-2011-002-AD3**

The Energy Commission is required under California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Chapter 8.1, Section 2343(c)(6), to consider the localized health impacts and environmental justice when approving projects for funding.

The *Localized Health Impacts Report for Selected Hydrogen Fuel Infrastructure Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-09-608* was posted on February 17, 2011, and the 30-day public comment period ended March 18, 2011. Two addendums to this report were posted on May 6, 2011 and May 20, 2013.

The Energy Commission has published a third addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that analyzes a new location of a project proposed for funding under the Program. Air Products and Chemicals, Inc plans to install a hydrogen fueling station at a gasoline station located at 7751 Beverly Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA. This hydrogen fueling station will replace the one planned for 1004 South La Cienega Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA. The addendum was publicly available on November 14, 2013.

The addendum to the report includes a description of the project, criteria emissions data for the fuels associated with the project, demographic data for the area where the project will be located, and an analysis of the impacts of this project in communities with the most significant exposure to air contaminants or localized air contaminants.
