**Notice of Sixth Addendum to the  
LOCALIZED HEALTH IMPACTS REPORT  
for  
Selected Projects Awarded Funding Through the  
Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology  
Program under Solicitation PON-09-608  
Publication CEC-600-2011-002-AD6**

The *Localized Health Impacts Report for Selected Hydrogen Fuel Infrastructure Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-09-608* was posted on February 17, 2011, and the 30-day public comment period ended March 18, 2011. Five addendums to this report were posted on May 6, 2011, May 20, 2013, November 14, 2013, January 16, 2014 and February 3, 2014.

The Energy Commission has published a sixth addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that analyzes a new location of a project proposed for funding under the Program. Air Products and Chemicals, Inc. plans to install a hydrogen fueling station at a gasoline station located at 1200 Beryl Street, Redondo Beach, CA. This hydrogen fueling station will replace the one planned for 1131 Pacific Coast Highway, Hermosa Beach, CA. The addendum was publicly available on March 4, 2014.

The addendum to the report includes a description of the project, criteria emissions data for the fuels associated with the project, demographic data for the area where the project will be located, and an analysis of the impacts of this project in communities with the most significant exposure to air contaminants or localized air contaminants.
