Notice of Fourth Addendum to the *LOCALIZED HEALTH IMPACTS REPORT*

Selected Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-09-006 Publication CEC-600-2010-005-AD4

The Energy Commission is required under California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Chapter 8.1, Section 2343(c)(6), to consider the localized health impacts and environmental justice when approving projects for funding.

The *Localized Health Impacts Report for Selected Alternative and Renewable Fuel Infrastructure Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-09-006* was posted on May 28, 2010, and the 30-day public comment period ended June 28, 2010. Three addendums to this report were posted on May 27, 2011, March 22, 2013, and December 5, 2013; each addendum had a 30-day comment period.

The Energy Commission has published a fourth addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that analyzes a new location of a project proposed for funding under the Program. The addendum was publicly available on July 16, 2014.

The addendum to the report includes a description of the project, criteria emissions data for the fuels associated with the project, demographic data for the area where the project will be located, and an analysis of the impacts of this project in communities with the most significant exposure to air contaminants or localized air contaminants.

The new station location proposed, in relation to South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) is the Clean Energy Perris station, located at 23261 Cajalco Expressway, Perris, CA. It is replacing the station located at 45601 Dillon Road, Coachella, CA.
