Notice of Addendum to the LOCALIZED HEALTH IMPACTS REPORT

Selected Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program Under Solicitation PON-13-609 **Publication CEC-600-2014-004-AD**

The Localized Health Impacts Report for *Selected Pilot-Scale and Commercial-Scale Advanced Biofuels Production Facilities Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program Under Solicitation PON-13-609* was posted on May 9, 2014 and the 30-day public comment period ended June 9, 2014.

On July 18, 2014, the California Energy Commission posted a Round 2 Notice of Proposed Awards resulting in additional projects proposed for funding under the Pilot-Scale and Commercial-Scale Advanced Biofuels Production Facilities grant solicitation PON-13-609. The Energy Commission is required under California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Chapter 8.1, Section 2343(c)(6), to consider the localized health impacts and environmental justice when approving projects for funding.

The Energy Commission has published an addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that analyzes the additional projects proposed for funding under the Program. The addendum was publicly available on August 11, 2014.

The addendum to the report includes a description of the projects, criteria emissions data for the fuels associated with the projects, demographic data for the areas where the projects will be located, and an analysis of the impacts of these projects in communities with the most significant exposure to air contaminants or localized air contaminants.

The specific projects analyzed in this report fall under three fuel categories and the projects are:
