The Energy Commission is required under California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Chapter 8.1, Section 2343(c)(6), to consider the localized health impacts and environmental justice when approving projects for funding.

The *Localized Health Impacts Report for Selected Pilot-Scale and Commercial-Scale Advanced Biofuels Production Facilities Projects awarded funding through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-13-609* was posted May 9, 2014, and the 30-day public comment period ended June 9, 2014. An addendum to this report was posted on August 11, 2014, and the 30-day public comment period ended September 10, 2014.

The Energy Commission has published a second addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that analyzes a new location and community impacts of a project proposed for funding under the Program. UrbanX Renewables Group, Inc., project “UrbanX Flex-RD BioRefinery: Phase 1” has changed location of the project from 1571 West 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Long Beach, California 90813 to 9302 Garfield Avenue, South Gate, California 90280. The addendum was publicly available on December 31, 2014.
