LOCALIZED HEALTH IMPACTS REPORT
for
Selected Projects Awarded Funding Through the
Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology
Program under Solicitation PON-13-606
Publication CEC-600-2014-002-AD6**

The Energy Commission is required under California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Chapter 8.1, Section 2343(c)(6), to consider the localized health impacts and environmental justice when approving projects for funding.

The *Localized Health Impacts Report for Selected Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-13-606* was posted on April 11, 2014, and the 30-day public comment period ended May 12, 2014. Five addendums to this report were posted on June 19, 2014, July 16, 2014, October 9, 2014, May 6, 2015 and June 2, 2015.

The Energy Commission has published a sixth addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that analyzes new locations of projects proposed for funding under the Program. This addendum reports on and assesses the potential localized health impacts of additional site locations for US Green Vehicle Council project entitled “Corridor DC Fast Charging Infrastructure on Interstate I-5 and Highway 99 from Stockton to San Diego”. The additional site locations for electric vehicle charging infrastructure are listed below. This addendum was publicly available on July 3, 2015.
