SUBJECT: PUBLIC WEBINAR TO DISCUSS THE TECHNICAL FORMULATION OF  
THE CALIFORNIA HYDROGEN INFRASTRUCTURE TOOL (CHIT)

Please join Air Resources Board (ARB) staff for an in-depth discussion of the underlying motivations, data, and methodologies used to develop the California Hydrogen Infrastructure Tool (CHIT). The discussion will focus on the definition and assessment of coverage provided by existing and planned hydrogen fueling stations and the likely first adopter market for Fuel Cell Electric Vehicles (FCEVs). This discussion will provide technical detail in support of the ARB's 2015 Annual Evaluation of Fuel Cell Electric Vehicle Deployment and Hydrogen Fuel Station Network Development<sup>1</sup> and the California Energy Commission's 2015 Staff Workshop on Draft Solicitation Concepts for Hydrogen Refueling Infrastructure<sup>2</sup>. The goal is to provide stakeholders with a comprehensive understanding of the analyses performed by the tool and an opportunity to provide feedback for desirable additional developments in future versions of the tool. The main technical discussion will be preceded by a primer of concepts key to understanding Geographical Information Systems, census data, and other fundamentals necessary to completely understand the development of the tool.


