**Notice of Fifth Addendum to the  
LOCALIZED HEALTH IMPACTS REPORT  
for  
Selected Projects Awarded Funding Through the  
Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology  
Program under Solicitation PON-13-607  
Publication CEC-600-2014-007-AD5**

The California Energy Commission is required under California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Chapter 8.1, Section 2343(c)(6), to consider the localized health impacts and environmental justice when approving projects for funding.

The *Localized Health Impacts Report for Selected Hydrogen Refueling Infrastructure Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-13-607* was posted on June 19, 2014, and the 30-day public comment period ended July 19, 2014. Four addendums to this report were posted on October 2, 2014, December 31, 2014, February 4, 2015, and January 22, 2016.

The Energy Commission has published a fifth addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that analyzes new locations of projects proposed for funding under the Program. This addendum reports on and assesses the potential localized health impacts of new site locations for First Element Fuel Inc. The new site locations for these projects are listed below. This addendum was publicly available on March 2, 2016.
