The California Energy Commission is required under California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Chapter 8.1, Section 2343(c)(6), to consider the localized health impacts and environmental justice when approving projects for funding.

The *Localized Health Impacts Report for Selected Hydrogen Refueling Infrastructure Projects Awarded Funding Through the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program under Solicitation PON-13-607* was posted on June 19, 2014, and the 30-day public comment period ended July 19, 2014. Five addendums to this report were posted on October 2, 2014, December 31, 2014, February 4, 2015, January 22, 2016, and March 2, 2016.

The Energy Commission has published a sixth addendum to the original Localized Health Impacts Report that analyzes a new location of a project proposed for funding under the Program. This addendum reports on and assesses the potential localized health impacts of new site location for HyGen Industries. The new site location for this project is listed below. This addendum was publicly available on April 15, 2016.
