Notice of Staff Webinar on Responses to Invitation to Submit Proposals in the 2012-2013 Appliance Efficiency Rulemaking

California Energy Commission staff will conduct a webinar to provide a brief overview of the results of the Invitation to Submit Proposals and to discuss next steps in the rulemaking proceeding.

Purpose

The purpose of this webinar is to share with interested parties an overview of the appliance energy efficiency proposals that the Energy Commission received in response to the June 13, 2013 Invitation to Submit Proposals. These proposals, along with the data and information received in response to the March 25, 2013 Invitation to Participate, will be the basis for determining which appliances merit further consideration in a formal rulemaking to establish minimum energy efficiency standards and other efficiency measures.

The proposals cover the following categories and appliances:

- Consumer Electronics (Docket #12-AAER-2A)
(Computers, Displays, Game Consoles, Set-top Boxes, and Network Equipment)
- Lighting (Docket #12-AAER-2B)
(Fluorescent Dimming Ballasts, Light-emitting Diodes, and Multifaceted Reflector Lamps)
- Water Appliances (Docket #12-AAER-2C)
(Faucets, Toilets, Urinals, and Water Meters)

- Other Appliances
 - Commercial Clothes Dryers (Docket #12-AAER-2D)
 - Air Filters (Docket #12-AAER-2E)
 - Residential Pool Pumps & Motors (Docket #12-AAER-2F)
 - Portable Electric Spas (Docket #12-AAER-2G)

Staff will also describe the next steps for this rulemaking proceeding.
