**Background**

Energy Commission staff are developing a voluntary quality specification for LED lamps that use E26 (“Edison screw”) and other types of ANSI-standard lamp sockets. This specification is being developed in collaboration with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC). CPUC Decision 12-05-015 directs the California investor owned utilities (for their 2013-2014 energy efficiency portfolios) to only propose rebates for screw-based LEDs products that are consistent with the quality specification developed by the Energy Commission. This specification is being developed in response to the findings of compact fluorescent lamp (CFL) incentive program evaluations, which found that the poor performance of CFL lamps was a major impediment to increased market penetration of those products. This specification would set a high performance standard that is intended to create a positive public perception of LED lamps, especially in residential applications. The draft specification will be available prior to the public meeting (see “Availability of Documents” below).

## **Public Comment**
