What is the DRMEC?

- ▶ The DRMEC grew out of a Working Group subcommittee first authorized in a CPUC decision in 2003 (D.03-06-032) and later formalized in 2006 (D. 06-11.049)
- ▶ Composed of representatives from
 - CPUC
 - CEC
 - PG&E
 - SDG&E
 - SCE



DRMEC Workshops

CPUC Decision 09-08-027 requires the DRMEC to conduct annual public workshops presenting the results of demand response evaluations conducted under its oversight



DRMEC Workshops, cont.

The DRMEC has chosen to divide these

- ▶ A fall workshop to present process evaluations
- ▶ A spring workshop to present load impact evaluations and enrollment forecasts
 - ▶ Workshop notices are posted on the CPUC website prior to the workshop.
