

GENESIS SOLAR ENERGY PROJECT

Consideration and possible adoption of the Committee's Presiding Member's Proposed Decision on the ***GENESIS SOLAR ENERGY PROJECT*** (Docket No. 09-AFC-8), and Errata. The Committee issued its Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD) on August 19, 2010.

The proposed Genesis Solar Energy Project would be a solar electric generating facility using solar parabolic trough technology with a generating capacity of 250 megawatts (MW). The project is located approximately 25 miles west of the city of Blythe, California on lands managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) in the Sonoran Desert.

The PMPD contains the Committee's rationale in determining that the proposed project will, as mitigated, have no significant impacts on the environment and will comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (LORS).
