

## ALMOND 2 POWER PLANT PROJECT

Consideration and possible adoption of the Committee's Presiding Member's Proposed Decision on the **ALMOND 2 POWER PLANT PROJECT** and possible Errata (Docket No. 09-AFC-2). The Committee issued its Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD) on November 12, 2010.

The proposed **ALMOND 2** Project will be a natural-gas-fired, simple-cycle peaking facility rated at a gross generating capacity of 174 megawatts (MW) and designed to provide TID with operating reserves. The project will occupy a 4.6-acre site, adjacent to the existing 48-MW Almond Power Plant, located in the county of Stanislaus, but within the city limits of Ceres.

The PMPD contains the Committee's rationale in determining that the proposed project will, as mitigated, comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (LORS).
