

RICE SOLAR ENERGY POWER PLANT PROJECT

Consideration and possible adoption of the Committee's Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD) on the **RICE SOLAR ENERGY POWER PLANT PROJECT**, and possible Errata (Docket No. 09-AFC-10).

The Committee issued its PMPD on November 12, 2010.

The Project site is located approximately 32 miles west of Parker, Arizona and approximately 40 miles northwest of Blythe, California in Riverside County, California. The power plant would occupy 1,410 acres of a larger 2,560-acre site and is designed to produce electricity at a capacity of 150 megawatts (MW) and annual energy of 450,000 megawatt-hours per year during periods of peak energy demands

The PMPD contains the Committee's rationale in determining that the proposed project will, as mitigated, comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (LORS).
