

Statement of Work/Objectives

Project Title: Glass Scanning Equipment for Solaria PV Manufacturing Facility in Fremont, CA

The Solaria Corporation (Solaria) will be using \$753,992.00 of federal ARRA-SEP funds awarded from the California Energy Commission to purchase a Glass Scanner and a PV Assembly Machine. The \$753,992.00 in funding is part of a larger \$3,512,013 project, with the remainder paid for with leverage funding by other sources, to expand a solar photovoltaic module plant to an annual capacity of 6 MW. Solaria will not be expanding the building footprint.

According to Solaria and the City of Fremont, no discretionary permits are required for the project. Solaria has stated in CEQA documentation filled out by a representative of the company that the project is in a site that is already zoned for industrial use. According to the GO-EF1 filled out by a representative of Solaria, there will not be any notable waste streams generated from the project.
