Re: Green Building Ordinance and the Building Energy Efficiency Standards

Dear Ms. Jones,

Per the request of Commission Staff, we would like to express to you our firm commitment to have the City of Mountain View enforce the current Title 24 Building Energy Efficiency Standards as part of the implementation of our local energy ordinance. As the Chief Building Official, I will work with my staff involved in energy plan review and field inspection to improve their working knowledge of the energy standards. This includes special training as needed which focuses on enforcement of the energy standards and the special requirements of the Ordinance.

During an open public hearing at their March 22, 2011 regularly calendared business meeting, Staff presented to the City Council the Mountain View Green Building Ordinance and the Energy Cost Effective Study. The Council recognized the study analysis showing energy saving and cost effectiveness and Council approved the Ordinances and Study.

The Mountain View Green Building Regulation will ensure that residential and non-residential buildings in the City will consume no more energy than permitted by Title 24, Part 6.
