The project proposes to install Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) at various locations on the UC San Diego campus. All power will be provided from the existing campus grid and the work includes installations of conduit, wiring, electrical connections and mounting equipment. Minor trenching will be required to bring power from local sources to proposed charging stations. Thus, the project consists of minor alteration of existing facilities and/or mechanical equipment involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing; including replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity and/or minor alterations to land, including minor trenching and backfilling where surface is restored.
