This e-mail is a respectful request that you vote to delay Title 24's implementation until July 2014. I am a salesperson that makes a living in this industry, so I am speaking from first-hand about my own personal experience. I am very concerned about what the new standards will do to the world of lighting retrofit in California. I am very concerned about my job. The industry just is not yet ready for the new and big changes.

There will be a tremendous learning curve to get up and running with these new, complicated energy efficiency requirements. Enough so, that I fear for all in the lighting business. There are not enough resources internal or external to assist with all new proposals, come January 1, '14. Title 24 will surely cause the current wheels in motion to bog down and freeze up, without adequate time to prepare for all of the new suppliers that will need to be sourced and added to a contractors "qualified supplier list". Trainings will need to be rolled out to the auditors & installation crews. Trainings that have not even been developed yet.

The really bigger issue which I won't even go in to here is the impact of costs for these new special controls. At this point they simply are not cost effective for any customers.

Please allow all industries affected by these significant changes, time to prepare for all that will be entailed to successfully meet the new requirements. It could mean the difference between a happy California or otherwise.

I hope you vote to delay the implementation. My job depends on it.
