**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 381 the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission (Energy Commission) is authorized to establish and administer the Public Interest Energy Research Program (PIER); and

**WHEREAS**, the Energy Commission has recognized that California’s electricity ratepayers benefit from energy research, development and demonstration (RD&D) activities conducted by academic institutions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Energy Commission has created the Enabling Technologies Development (ETD) Program within the PIER Program to provide funding for the aforementioned public interest RD&D activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Energy Commission has designated the Regents of the University of California, California Institute for Energy and Environment (CIEE) to serve as the ETD Program Administrator (under Agreement Number 500-01-043, Amendment 5) to solicit grant applications, recommend grant awards to the Energy Commission, and manage authorized grant projects; and

**WHEREAS**, CIEE has now completed Solicitation 13-02 and has submitted to Energy Commission’s RD&D Staff the qualifying applicants for award; and

**WHEREAS**, the Energy Commission’s RD&D Staff has reviewed and recommends one distribution grid and two smart home projects for awards in the documentation attached to this resolution.
