Order Accepting the Executive Director’s Data Adequacy Recommendation

On April 15, 2015, NRG Oxnard Energy Center, LLC (Applicant) submitted an Application for Certification (AFC) to the California Energy Commission to construct the Puente Power Project (P3) on a three-acre site at the existing Mandalay Generating Station in the City of Oxnard.

Puente Power Project is a proposed nominal 262-megawatt (MW) natural gas-fired, fast starting, single-cycle gas-turbine, air-cooled generating facility with a net generating capacity range of 241 net MW to a peak of 271 MW.

Energy Commission Staff completed its data adequacy review of the AFC in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1704, and Division 2, Chapter 5, Appendix B for the 12-month permitting process. On May 13, 2015, Robert Oglesby, Executive Director, issued a letter with Staff’s determination that the AFC did not meet all of the requirements as required by the Commission’s regulations in the areas of Air Quality, Public Health, and Transmission System Engineering.

On June 1, 2015, Applicant submitted a composite package of information that successfully addressed the above information deficiencies. On June 2, 2015, the Executive Director issued a subsequent letter in which Staff made the determination that all of the outstanding information was received, and recommends that the AFC be deemed complete for data adequacy purposes.

The Energy Commission adopts the Executive Director’s Data Adequacy Recommendation, and accepts the Puente Power Project Application as complete.
