**RESOLUTION: APPROVAL OF MOA WITH WESTERN AREA POWER ADMINISTRATION**

**WHEREAS**, the California Energy Commission (“Commission”) is the repository for all California electric infrastructure information, including GIS data to determine locational characteristics of the state-wide electric transmission system, and

**WHEREAS**, state law enables the Commission to designate appropriate electric transmission corridor zones, and

**WHEREAS**, the Western Area Power Administration (“Western”) is a federal agency that markets and delivers power and related services within the western United States including California pursuant to federal law, and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the interest of both the Commission and Western to share data regarding locational characteristics of the statewide transmission system, and

**WHEREAS**, both agencies believe it is useful to have an express common understanding regarding the sharing of data, and respective agency responsibilities, therefore

**RESOLVED**, that the Energy Commission authorizes the Executive Director to enter into the attached Memorandum of Agreement (“MOA”), and to execute the same on behalf of the Commission.
