On January 7, 2016, the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) released a Grant Solicitation and Application Package entitled "Freight Transportation Projects at California Seaports" under the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program (ARFVTP). This grant solicitation was an offer to fund projects that demonstrate freight transportation projects for medium- and heavy-duty vehicle technologies, demonstrate intelligent transportation systems and technologies, and deployment of natural gas vehicles.
