Regional Plans to Support Plug-In Electric Vehicle Readiness

June 19, 2012

On May 12, 2011, the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) released a Grant Solicitation Application Package entitled "Regional Plans to Support Plug-In Electric Vehicle Readiness" under the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program. The grant solicitation was offered to help prepare California regions for the rollout of Plug-in Electric Vehicles (PEVs). Funds will help regions develop PEV strategic plans for PEV electric vehicle supply equipment (EVSE), establish best practices for "PEV-ready" building and public works guidelines, and help to streamline PEV EVSE permitting, installation, and inspection processes. Regions are required to establish a PEV Coordinating Council with a lead agency which may receive up to \$200,000 per award. Applications are scored as pass or fail and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. The maximum funding available under this solicitation is \$2,000,000.

The Revised Notice of Proposed Awards reflects an additional Awardee. The attached table, "Revised Notice of Proposed Awards", identifies each applicant with a passing score selected to receive funding, the project title, the amount of funding recommended by Energy Commission staff, and the order in which applications were received. Funding of proposed projects resulting from this solicitation is contingent upon the approval of these projects at a publicly noticed Business Meeting at the Energy Commission in Sacramento, California, and execution of an Agreement.
