On August 23, 2013, the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) released a Grant Solicitation and Application Package entitled "Centers for Alternative Fuels and Advanced Vehicle Technology" under the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program (ARFVTP). This grant solicitation was an offer to fund projects that develop new centers or expand existing centers for alternative fuels and advanced vehicle technology. The grant solicitation announced that there is a total of \$4.7 million available for the agreements resulting from this solicitation and that the Energy Commission, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to increase or reduce the amount of funds available.

The attached table, "Revised Notice of Proposed Awards", identifies an additional applicant selected and recommended for funding by Energy Commission staff and includes the amount of recommended funding and score. Funding of proposed projects resulting from this solicitation is contingent upon the approval of these projects at a publicly noticed Energy Commission Business Meeting and execution of a grant agreement. If the Energy Commission is unable to timely negotiate and execute a funding agreement with an Applicant, the Energy Commission, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to cancel the pending award.
