**NOTICE OF PROPOSED AWARD (NOPA)****Residential Appliance Saturation Survey (RASS) 2017
RFP-16-802
March 15, 2017**

On January 25, 2017, the California Energy Commission released a competitive solicitation to select one contractor to develop and implement the Residential Appliance Saturation Survey (RASS) 2017. This project will extend previous surveys and the information gathered will be used for policy analysis, energy demand forecasting and measurement of energy savings in the residential sector. Up to \$2.8 million in funding is available for this solicitation. Of this amount, \$1.5 million is immediately available. The remaining balance of \$1.3 million may be available contingent upon approval of funds for fiscal year 2017-18.

The Energy Commission received three proposals by the due date of February 21, 2017. The proposals were screened, reviewed, evaluated and scored using the criteria in the solicitation.

The attached "Notice of Proposed Award" identifies the Bidder that is recommended for funding by Energy Commission staff and includes the recommended funding amount and score. The total amount recommended is \$2,692,841.

Funding of the proposed project resulting from this solicitation is also contingent upon the approval of the project at a publicly noticed Energy Commission Business Meeting and execution of a contract agreement. If the Energy Commission is unable to timely execute a contract with the Bidder, the Energy Commission, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to cancel or otherwise modify the pending award.
