## **Energy Partnership Program Temporary Suspension of Technical Assistance Program**

The Energy Commission is temporarily suspending technical assistance provided under the Energy Partnership Program (EPP). Due to workload constraints associated with American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds technical assistance will not be offered to EPP applicants after December 3, 2009.

Typically, the technical assistance program has provided energy audits to identify energy saving recommendations or reviews of energy proposals and designs.

Technical assistance will continue to be conducted for ARRA related activities.

### **Who does this affect?**

Non-ARRA applicants such as cities, counties, special districts, public schools, colleges and universities, public care institutions, and public hospitals.
