RE: Proposition 39 Citizens Oversight Board Appointments

Dear Mr. Chiang, Mr. Lockyer, Mr. Weisenmiller, and Mr. Peevey:

Proposition 39, passed by California voters in November 2012, established the Clean Energy Job Creation Fund ("Fund") to finance energy efficiency and clean energy projects. To ensure that taxpayer money in the Fund is spent in the most cost-effective manner, Proposition 39 established the Citizens Oversight Board ("Board"). The Board is comprised of nine members appointed in equal numbers by the State Attorney General, State Treasurer and State Controller, and two ex officio members representing the California Energy Commission and the California Public Utilities Commission. Consistent with implementing legislation enacted in September 2014, members of the Board are charged with annually reviewing all expenditures from the Fund, commissioning and reviewing an annual audit of the Fund, and providing the Legislature with an annual program evaluation that identifies any improvements it believes are needed.

With great pleasure, I appoint the following individuals to the Board:

- Mr. Arno Harris is Chief Executive Officer of Recurrent Energy, one of North America's largest solar project developers. He earned his Bachelors Degree in English Literature from the University of California, Berkeley.
- Mr. Randall Martinez is Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer of Cordoba Corporation, a consulting firm that specializes in infrastructure development by providing civil engineering, project and construction management services. He earned his Bachelors Degree in Business Administration/Finance from the University of Southern California and is licensed in California as a general engineering contractor.
- Ms. Chelina Odbert is Co-Founder and Executive Director of Kounkuey Design Initiative, a partnership specializing in architecture, landscape architecture and urban planning to create open spaces that link physical upgrading to community development. She earned her Bachelor of Arts, Magna Cum Laude and Phi Beta Kappa from Claremont McKenna College and completed her Master of Urban Planning at Harvard University.

Mr. Harris, Mr. Martinez, and Ms. Odbert will serve California well by ensuring the funds raised through Proposition 39 are spent on projects that can result in a cleaner and brighter California. They bring a wealth of experience and proven expertise; I am confident they will provide invaluable contributions as the Board carries out its critical mission.
