



California Energy Commission Announces Training Webinar for Proposition 39 Program

On **Wednesday, March 25, 2015**, from 9:00 AM to 12:30 PM, the California Energy Commission will host a webinar to provide information to Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) and the public on the Proposition 39 Program and the updated Energy Expenditure Plan application process.

Topics for this Webinar include:

- A brief overview of the Proposition 39: California Clean Energy Jobs Act Program.
- An explanation of the recently adopted 2015 Proposition 39 Guidelines (adopted Dec. 2014).
- A step-by-step introduction to the **NEW** Energy Expenditure Online Application System. Energy Commission staff will guide LEAs through the new online system, show how to complete and submit an application, upload documents and edit information after submittal, if needed.
- An overview of the recently updated Energy Expenditure Plan Handbook, which provides detailed instructions to assist LEAs in completing and submitting their Energy Expenditure Plans.
- A synopsis of the updated Utility Data Release Authorization Forms (revised Feb. 2015), which are required with the first Energy Expenditure Plan submission and will authorize the Energy Commission to access the LEA's electric and gas energy usage and billing data.
- An examination of the updated Energy Savings Calculators (Version 6), including sample calculations, which may be used by LEAs to estimate energy savings for simple projects without a professional energy survey or audit.
- A review of the **NEW** LEA Project SIR Worksheet, which is available for LEAs to use to help evaluate which Energy Efficiency Measures, Photovoltaic Measures, or Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) Measures to include in their Energy Expenditure Plans.
