Notice Regarding Creation of Master Distribution List for SB 1368 Notifications

On June 18, 2014, the Energy Commission adopted modifications to its regulations implementing Senate Bill 1368 (Stats. 2006, Ch. 598). On August 28, 2014, the Office of Administrative Law approved these modifications, which will go into effect on October 1, 2014. The new regulations (California Code of Regulations, Title 20, section 2908[a]) require the Energy Commission to “create, maintain, and make available on its website a master contact list containing the names and email addresses of all persons who have requested to be notified when a publicly owned utility (POU) issues a notice,” pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 20, section 2908(b).

Those on the master list will receive notification of the following:

- The date, time, and location of all POU public meetings to consider a covered procurement or any investment of \$2.5 million or more to meet environmental regulatory requirements at a non-Emission Performance Standard (EPS) compliant baseload facility, or a link to the URL where such information can be found; and
- Any information related to a covered procurement's compliance with the EPS or any investment of \$2.5 million or more to meet environmental regulatory requirements at a non-EPS compliant baseload facility that will be considered by a POU at a noticed public meeting, or a link to the URL where such documents can be found.

The Energy Commission is currently in the process of compiling this master list and requests that all persons interested in being notified when a POU issues a notice pursuant to Section 2908(b) to please email Michael Nyberg at michael.nyberg@energy.ca.gov by 3:00 p.m. on September 29, 2014. Include in the subject line of the email “Master SB 1368 contact list” and in the body include your full name, affiliation, if any, and the email address at which you would like to receive the notifications. Please be advised that this information will be posted and publicly available on the Energy Commission’s website.
