

Assess the nature and scope of energy use in your jurisdiction





Next Steps: Getting Started – cont.

- Ask questions
- Organize a committee with the right people from diverse backgrounds
- Contact other cities and local agencies



Next Steps: Getting Started

- Prepare a list of planning opportunity strategies that seem most suited for your jurisdiction
- Group the ideas in sets and put in order of priority



Next Steps: Getting Started – cont.

- Roughly estimate the costs and benefits of taking action
- Engage interested agencies and other stakeholders
- Consider linking to general plan updates or regional planning processes
- Consider how strategies will be funded and who is responsible for implementation
