Section 2: Describe the entity's business activity or its nature and interests.

Energy Foundation China, established in Beijing in 1999, is a grant-making charity organization dedicated to China's sustainable energy development. Its vision is to achieve prosperity and a safe climate through sustainable energy in China. EFC's mission is to achieve decarbonization, world-class air quality, and green growth through dramatically expanding renewable energy, significantly improving energy efficiency, and optimizing economic structure.

Section 3.2: Specific description of the payment and its agency purpose and use.

Janea A. Scott, a Commissioner at the California Energy Commission (CEC) will participate at the China EV100 event *Global Zero Emission and All Electric Vehicles Summit and Global EV Development and Policy Roundtable Meeting*. This 3 day forum will consist of 15 different events, with 200 speakers including domestic and foreign officials, scientist, entrepreneurs, and innovations leaders. This event will convene a group of world-wide electric vehicles (EV) experts to discuss topics such as 1) the strategies, policy mechanisms, and plans for promoting zero emission vehicles, 2) the policies, legislations, and incentives for banning fossil fuel vehicles, 3) creating international demonstrations and collaboration for zero emission vehicles, and 4) global polices to facilitate the synergy among electric vehicles, transportation, energy, and city design.

As the Energy Commissioner's lead on transportation, Commissioner Scott will take an active, leading role in shaping the discussion around important issues during these meetings. She'll have the opportunity to participate as a plenary speaker during the Global Zero Emission and All Electric Vehicle Summit, and as a participant during the Global EV Development and Policy Roundtable Meeting.
