

The Climate Registry (TCR) is a non-profit organization governed by U.S. states and Canadian provinces and territories. TCR was established in 2007 to continue the work of the California Climate Action Registry, which promotes and facilitates efforts by businesses to manage and reduce their greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. Today, TCR's activities include: designing and operating voluntary and compliance GHG reporting programs; assisting organizations in measuring, reporting, and verifying the carbon intensity of their operations; and consulting with national and international governments on GHG reporting.
