Section 2: Describe the entity's business activity or its nature and interests.

The U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) Hydrogen and Fuel Cell Technical Advisory Committee (HTAC) has biannual meetings. Vice Chair Scott is an appointed member of HTAC. The HTAC was established under Section 807 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 to provide technical and programmatic advice to the Energy Secretary on the DOE's hydrogen research, development, and demonstration efforts. The HTAC includes representatives from industry, academia, government agencies, financial organizations, and environmental groups.

Section 3.2: Specific description of the payment and its agency purpose and use.

Janea A. Scott, Vice Chair at the California Energy Commission (CEC) participated at the HTAC meeting, which provided a forum to engage with key leaders in the hydrogen industry. DOE provided a sustainable transportation update and the committee discussed a range of topics including policies and best practices, hydrogen safety, codes, standards, and hydrogen station and vehicle deployments.

As the Energy Commission's lead on transportation, Vice Chair Scott oversees transportation policy issues and implementation. Her participation at the HTAC meeting allowed her to share successes and lessons learned with other HTAC members, as well as ensuring that California's perspective is considered and influences the continued development of the nation's hydrogen and transportation policies.
