Rulemaking Overview

- Provide federal alignment and administrative updates to Title 20, CCR sections 1601-1609 (the "Appliance Efficiency Regulations")
- Does not propose any new energy or water efficiency standards for appliances, nor increases in stringency for existing standards



- Clarifications ease compliance for manufacturers
- Eliminates duplicative and outdated information
- Regulations will reflect both state and federal requirements in a single location

- Updates to align with current US DOE regulations
- Updates and streamlining to CEC's enforcement related product compliance review and administrative proceedings



Overview of Changes Cont.

- Updates to data submittal requirements for certain appliances
- Removal of a redundant aspect of the marking requirement for commercial and industrial fans and blowers
- Other changes for clarity and consistency
