We are suspending our review of SES Terminal, LLC's (SES) Long Beach LNG Import Project based on the fact that SES does not have access to or control of its proposed LNG import terminal site. As confirmed by your February 15, 2008 response to our Environmental Information Request, nothing has changed regarding the status of a lease since receiving the Board of Harbor Commissioners' January 22, 2007 letter declining to enter into a lease with SES for the site. If in the future SES secures control of the terminal site, we will reinitiate processing SES' application for the Long Beach LNG Import Project.
