NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**SUBJECT: ROUTES FOR THE THROUGH TRANSPORTATION OF
HIGHWAY ROUTE CONTROLLED QUANTITY SHIPMENTS OF
RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS**

The California Highway Patrol (CHP) proposes to adopt regulations in the California Code of Regulations relating to the routes used for the through transportation of highway route controlled quantity shipments of radioactive materials (HRCQ RAM).

INFORMATIVE DIGEST

Pursuant to Section 33000 of the California Vehicle Code, the California Highway Patrol is establishing route designations for the through transportation of HRCQ RAM. The federal government has designated all interstate highways as approved routes for the through transportation of HRCQ RAM. The California Highway Patrol is proposing to designate only those interstate routes necessary for the through transportation of HRCQ RAM. The regulations contain identifying preferred routes for the transportation of HRCQ RAM pursuant to Section 33000 of the California Vehicle Code.

The "Radioactive Materials Transportation Routing Study - Designation of Routes for the Through Transportation of Highway Route Controlled Quantity Shipments of Radioactive Materials" is available for public review at each California Highway Patrol Division Office, and the California Highway Patrol, Hazardous Materials Section, 444 North Third Street, Suite 310, Sacramento, CA.
