

NOTICE OF RENEWABLE POWER STANDARDS (RPS) MEETING
Renewable Portfolio Standard Plan Before Council

Background

On April 12, 2011, Governor Brown signed into law Senate Bill X1 2, establishing a Renewables Portfolio Standard of 33 percent by 2020 for all entities in California who provide electric resources. This law, therefore, applies to the City of Gridley's Electric Utility, a publicly owned utility.

SBX1 2 establishes minimum quantities of renewable energy resources that load serving entities must procure annually through 2020. Like all other entities covered under the new law, the City of Gridley is required to develop and implement a Renewable Energy Procurement Plan and Enforcement Program to show compliance with this law.
