

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a regular meeting of the Redding City Council on October 15, 2013, at 6:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, located at 777 Cypress Avenue, Redding, California, the City Council will consider adoption of the City of Redding's Renewables Portfolio Standard (RPS) plan for renewable resource procurement and revisions to the City of Redding's policy for enforcement of the RPS.

For consideration is a plan for the procurement of renewable resources and revisions to the City of Redding's policy for enforcement of the RPS, pursuant to the passage of Senate Bill 2 in the First Extraordinary Session (SBX1-2). SBX1-2 mandates all electric utilities in California to acquire 33 percent of their annual energy needs from renewable resources by 2020. It also requires each publicly-owned utility to adopt a program for enforcement of the legislation by January 1, 2012.

On December 20, 2011, the Redding City Council passed Resolution 2011-197, which adopted the City of Redding's policy for enforcement of the RPS. Revisions to the City of Redding's policy for enforcement of the RPS are being considered to include optional compliance measures allowable by the California Energy Commission.

On October 1, 2013, the "Enforcement Procedures for the Renewables Portfolio Standard for Local Publicly-Owned Electric Utilities," adopted by the California Energy Commission, became effective. A plan for procurement of renewable resources must be adopted by each publicly-owned utility within 60 calendar days of this effective date.
