AC Transit to Announce Opening of Innovative Hydrogen Fueling Facility

On Tuesday, April 10, 2012, AC Transit, and a coalition of regional transit partners serving 7 million people in the Bay Area, will unveil the latest generation of zero-emission fuel cell buses and the newest hydrogen production and dispensing station entering service, promising to reduce emissions throughout the region. The station will not only service AC Transit's buses, but it will be the first large-scale publicly accessible station to support the deployment of fuel cell cars to customers in the Bay Area.
