Electric Program Investment Charge: Proposed 2015-2017 Triennial Investment Plan **[CEC-500-2014-038-CMF/Docket No. 12-EPIC-01]**

On April 22, 2014, the California Energy Commission adopted the *Electric Program Investment Charge: Proposed 2015-2017 Triennial Investment Plan*. This EPIC plan will continue providing funding opportunities for clean energy innovation, harnessing the creative talents of researchers and entrepreneurs, and enabling them to turn new energy ideas into realities that provide ratepayer benefits and help the state achieve its energy goals in a cost-beneficial manner.

The Energy Commission would like to thank the many stakeholders that participated in the development of this plan. More than 150 public comments were received in developing this EPIC plan. These comments were instrumental in helping to develop funding initiatives that will lead to a cleaner, safer, more reliable and more resilient electricity system. The Energy Commission held public workshops February 7 and March 17, 2014, in Sacramento, and March 21, 2014, in Southern California. Commenters and participants provided productive feedback and helped shape this comprehensive plan.

This EPIC plan was prepared in accordance with California Public Utilities Commission Decision 12-05-037, and consistent with the Energy Commission's broad authority under Public Resources Code sections 25216(c) and 25401, as well as Public Resources Code section 25710, et seq. This EPIC plan was developed with the input and guidance of Energy Commission Chair Robert B. Weisenmiller, in his capacity as the lead commissioner on research, development and demonstration matters.
