Background

The Electric Program Investment Charge (EPIC) Program was established by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) in 2011 to fund public interest investments in applied research and development, technology demonstration and deployment, and market facilitation of clean energy technologies and approaches for the benefit of electricity ratepayers of Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E), and Southern California Edison Company (SCE).

The Energy Commission's first EPIC triennial investment plan was approved as modified by the California Public Utilities Commission in Decision 13-11-025 in November 2013. The [2012-14 Triennial EPIC Investment Plan](#) includes Strategic Objective S9 (Advance Plug-In Electric Vehicle Infrastructure and Use electric vehicles to Improve the Operation and Performance of California's Power Grid), which is intended to optimize the benefits of plug-in electric vehicles to the electricity system.

Through this workshop, staff will seek industry input to focus research, development, and demonstration efforts under Strategic Objective S9 to maximize benefits to electricity ratepayers and the state as it prepares for increased deployment of electric vehicles. Specific topics of discussion will include demand-side management strategies and smart or managed charging for electric vehicles.
