**Regarding request for written comments concerning EPIC program:**

As the community owned and operated provider of electric generation and distribution for the City of Roseville, California. Roseville Electric (RE) and RE ratepayers have been the beneficiary of the ongoing research and market implementation efforts conducted by the California Lighting Technology Center, UC Davis (CLTC). Membership in the CLTC continues to provide RE with the essential support and information need to develop and implement high efficiency lighting and controls programs within our service territory.

RE serves 31 square miles and 57,000 meters. High efficiency lighting has formed the backbone of our energy efficiency programs. Our limited size translates to limited resources. The worked performed by the CLTC has allowed RE to focus a greater percentage of our resources on success lighting efficiency program implementation. RE simply does not have the resources at hand to perform the development function supported at the CLTC.

The CLTC has been an important part of our ability to meet state energy efficiency mandates and service our ratepayers with valuable programs.

The continued investment in the CLTC and the EPIC Program concept creates opportunities of success programs and creates valuable consortiums of both IOU and community owed electric providers.
